But Jesus answered and said unto them, **Ye do err, *not knowing the scriptures*, nor the power of God.**



How Jesus saw the Bible

Mt. 5:19 - Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, shall be called least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, he shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Jn. 10:35 –

**If he called them gods, unto whom the
word of God came (and the scripture
cannot be broken),**

Jn. 5:39 -

Ye search the scriptures, because ye think that in them ye have eternal life; and these are they which bear witness of me;

Lk. 24:27 -

And beginning from Moses and from all the prophets, he interpreted to them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

Mk. 7:10 -

For Moses said, Honor thy father and thy mother; and, He that speaketh evil of father or mother, let him die the death:

Mt. 24:15 -

When therefore ye see the abomination of desolation, which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (let him that readeth understand),



Lk. 16:29-31 - **How Jesus saw the Bible**

29 But Abraham saith, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.

30 And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but **if one go to them from the dead, they will repent.**

31 And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, if one rise from the dead.

Mt. 22:31-32 -

But as touching the resurrection of the **dead**, have ye not read that which was spoken unto you by God, saying, 32 I **am the God** of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? God is not (the God) of the dead, but of the living.

How Jesus saw the Bible

Mt. 12:39-41 - But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given it but the sign of Jonah the prophet: 40 for as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the whale; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. 41 The men of Nineveh shall stand up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for they repented at the preaching of Jonah; and behold, a greater than Jonah is here.

Lk. 11:51 -

from the blood of Abel unto the blood of Zachariah, who perished between the altar and the sanctuary: yea, I say unto you, it shall be required of this generation.



How Jesus saw the Bible

Jn. 8:56 -

**Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day;
and he saw it, and was glad.**



How Jesus saw the Bible

Lk. 17:26-27 -

And as it came to pass in the days of Noah, even so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man. 27 They ate, they drank, they married, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all.



How Jesus saw the Bible

Lk. 17:29, 32 -

29. but in the day that Lot went out from Sodom it rained
fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all:

32 Remember Lot's wife.



How Jesus saw the Bible

Jn. 6:31 -

Our fathers ate the manna in the wilderness; **as it is written**, He gave them bread out of heaven to eat.

Jn. 3:14 -

**And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness,
even so must the Son of man be lifted up;**
