Rom. 7:2-4

2 For the woman that hath a husband is bound by law to the husband while he liveth; but if the husband die, she is discharged from the law of the husband.

3 So then if, while the husband liveth, she be joined to another man, she shall be called an adulteress: but if the husband die, she is free from the law, so that she is no adulteress, though she be joined to another man.

4 Wherefore, my brethren, ye also were made dead to the law through the body of Christ; that ye should be joined to another, (even) to him who was raised from the dead, that we might bring forth fruit unto God.

Eph. 5:22-23

22 Wives, (be in subjection) unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. 23 For the husband is the head of the wife, and Christ also is the head of the church, (being) himself the saviour of the body.

If ye love me, ye will keep my commandments.

Point # 3 (Wholehearted Commitment)

Mt. 22:37

And he said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind.

Rom. 12:11

in diligence not slothful; fervent in spirit;
serving the Lord;

Point # 4 (one man)

Acts 4:11-12 + Mt. 16:18

Acts 4:11: He is the stone which was set at nought of you the builders, which was made the head of the corner.

Acts 4:12: And in none other is there salvation: for neither is there any other name under heaven, that is given among men, wherein we must be saved.



Point # 5 (obedience)

1 Pet. 3:1-6 + Acts 20:28

In like manner, ye wives, (be) in subjection to your own husbands; that, even if any obey not the word, they may without the word be gained by the behavior of their wives; 2 beholding your chaste behavior (coupled) with fear. 3 Whose (adorning) let it not be the outward adorning of braiding the hair, and of wearing jewels of gold, or of putting on apparel; 4 but (let it be) the hidden man of the heart, in the incorruptible (apparel) of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price. 5 For after this manner aforetime the holy women also, who hoped in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection to their own husbands: 6 as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose children ye now are, if ye do well, and are not put in fear by any terror.



Point # 5 (obedience, part 2)

Lk. 22:19 – “this do in remembrance of me.”

Acts 20:7- And upon the first day of the week, when we were gathered together to break bread

Acts 2:42 (Young’s Literal Translation) - and they were continuing stedfastly in the teaching of the apostles, and the fellowship, and the breaking of the bread, and the prayers.





Point # 6 (Being Faithful)

2 Thess. 3:3

But the Lord is faithful, who shall establish you, and guard you from the evil (one).

1 Cor. 7:34b:

but she that is married *is careful* for the things of the world, how she may please her husband.



Point # 7 (One Flesh)

Mark 10:7-8

7 For this cause **shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife;**
8 and **the two shall become one flesh:** so that they are no more two, but one flesh.

Col 2:12 + Rom. 6:4-5

having been buried with him in baptism, wherein ye were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead.



Point #8 (Joy and Peace)

Acts 8:39

And when they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip; and the eunuch saw him no more, for he went on his way rejoicing.

Phil. 4:4

Rejoice in the Lord always: again I will say,
Rejoice.



Point #9 (Upset Husband)

Eph. 2:4

“but God, being rich in mercy”

1 Jn .1:9

he is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness

Rom 5:9 + Rom. 5:2

saved from the wrath + stand in grace

Point #9 (Upset Husband)

Jer. 3:6

Moreover Jehovah said unto me in the days of Josiah the king, Hast thou seen that which backsliding Israel hath done? she is gone up upon every high mountain and under every green tree, and there hath played the harlot.

Jer. 3:8

And I saw, when, for this very cause that backsliding Israel had committed adultery, I had put her away and given her a bill of divorcement, yet treacherous Judah her sister feared not; but she also went and played the harlot.





Point #10 (Assume Debts)

Isa. 53:4

Surely he hath borne our griefs, and
carried our sorrows;

1 Jn. 2:2

and he is the propitiation for our sins;
and not for ours only, but also for the
whole world.



Point #11 (Share This News)

Lk. 24:47

and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in his name *unto all the nations*, beginning from Jerusalem.

Eph. 6:4

And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but nurture them in the chastening and admonition of the Lord.
